Fishing Classes

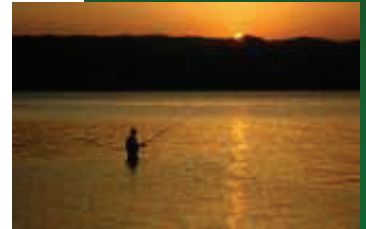
