Salt Searun Outing

It's time to start thinking of our annual Salt Searun Outing. The cutt fishing this year so far has been excellent with cutts running from 10 to 16" with some jumpers 18-20". This year the most all fish have been taken on top water presentations. Early in the season we had a fair number of big Dolly's in the mix but most have headed back to their native rivers by now. Consistent producing flies have been top water baitfish imitations such as the Gurgler, Skating Sandlance, Lelands Myawaky sp. Popper. Top water action that can be really intense when they are on a feeding frenzy, Small clousers (2-3") in chartreuse/white, orange/white, red/white.

If you don't have any bait fish Spiders in red, white, gray or black will also work. Werner Shrimp (yes, werner shrimp). We will be fishing water only 6' to 8' deep max. Five or 6wt rods are the norm with either a full sink or an intermediate clear full sink or my favorite a clear intermediate streamer tip. It is important to be on the water early so we will launch at the Marysville ramp between 6:00-6:30am. Priest Point will be our destination approximately 2 miles out Ebby Slough.

Fishing will slack off close to the high but there is still an opportunity for the outgoing bite pending wind and sun. Following we will meet at the Marysville Village Restaurant at approximately noon for brunch and fish stories.

Bring a friend; hope to see you all there.
