Lake Martha event

As I'm sure you recall, the club was able to convince the state to designate Lake Martha near Warm Beach as a quality fishery last year. The major change in regulation is that no bait is allowed.

In order to make the lake a quality fishery, the state Department of Fish and Wildlife needs to have a good sense of the number and size of the fish that are in the lake and of their general health.

That's where we come in.

The club is planning to hold a fish out at the lake on June 16. We will be recording the number of fish we catch and also their length up to one-quarter of an inch. The club will provide the measuring devices. We can talk more about this at our upcoming meeting. But I'm hoping as many people as possible will save the date and plan on coming to the event to help.

Also, in talking with Biologist Justin Spinelli, it was clear that the state is getting some push back from those who can no longer fish the lake using bait. The gist is that it doesn't look like a lot of people are fishing the lake, so why can't bait anglers go back to the way things used to be?

The bottom line is that we can help ourselves by fishing the lake more and by helping the state get more information so it can provide the appropriate stocking numbers and regulations. I know the state has done some test netting and in one case came up with a giant brown trout. But it doesn't have the money to hire a bunch of people to gather the kind of data it needs. So let's help.


